




But how?

Setting up a bit of perspective

Usually marketers think the post gets viral this way




But in reality, it's



When an influencer in the industry shares your content with their audience, the post reaches maximum potential (large audience) and then **decays** over time.

Think of it like an inverted pyramid



But what if LinkedIn limits your reach?

That's where you got to make big-shots influencers interact with your post

- They liked your post? Good!
- They commented on your post? Great!
- They reposted? Best!

But what if they're not interested?

They'll be interested! Here's an example!

Saurav Agarwal sure - there are a few reasons:




