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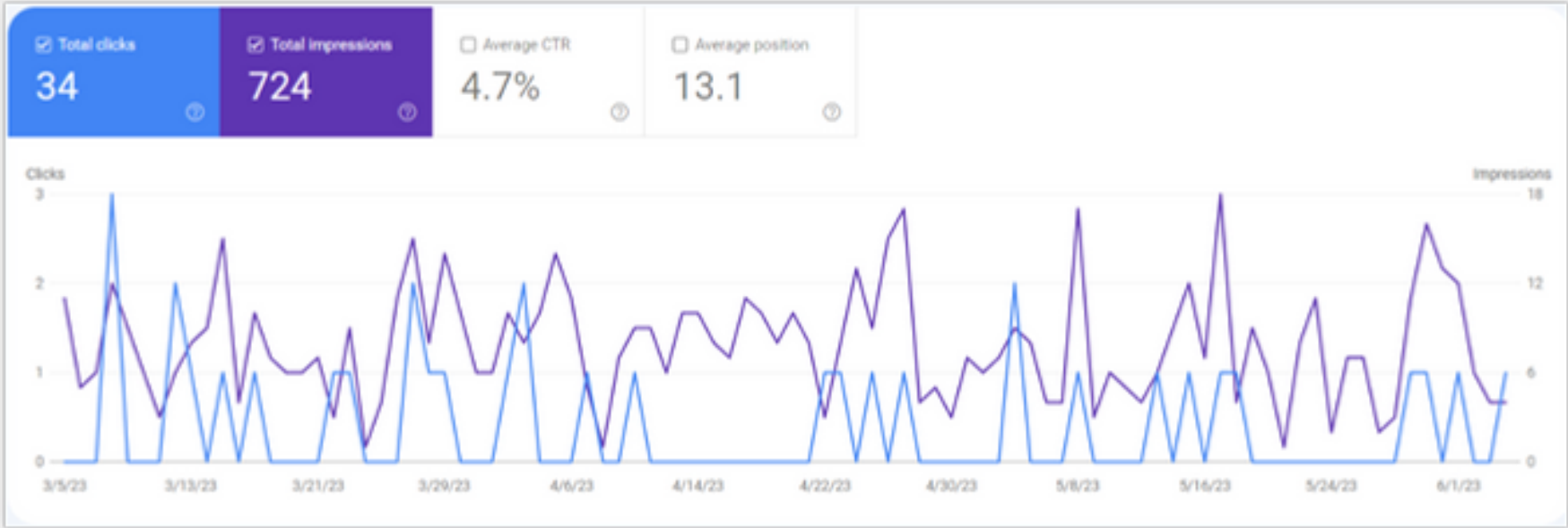

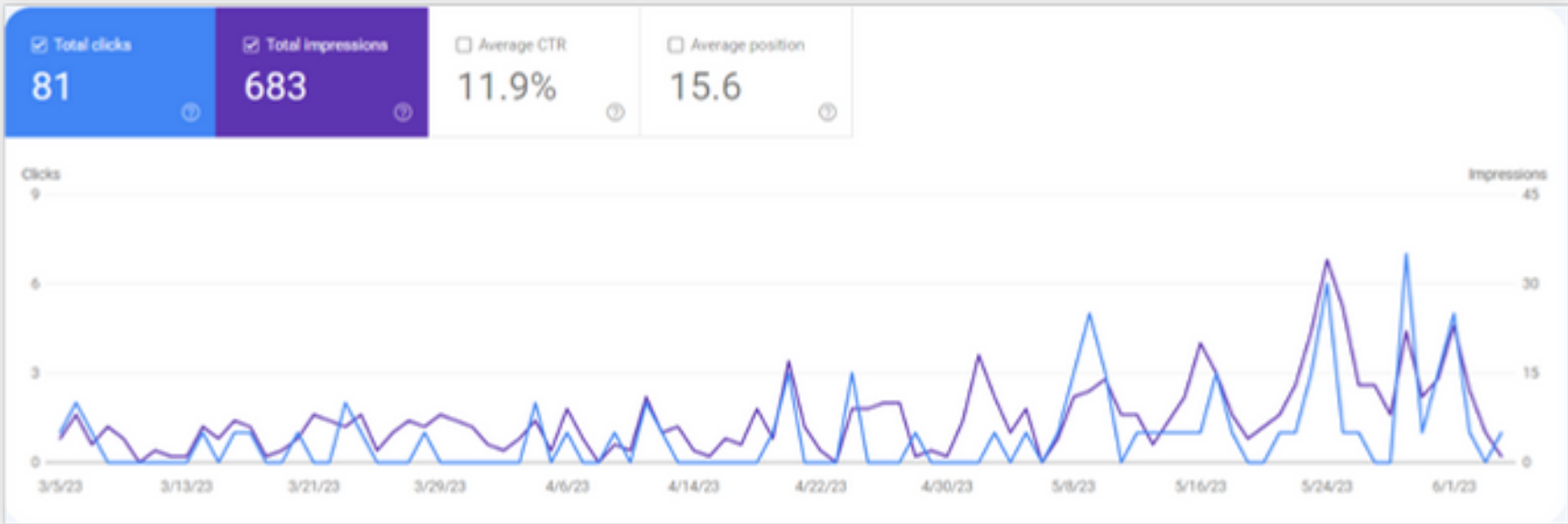

Step 4: Use dedicated URLs

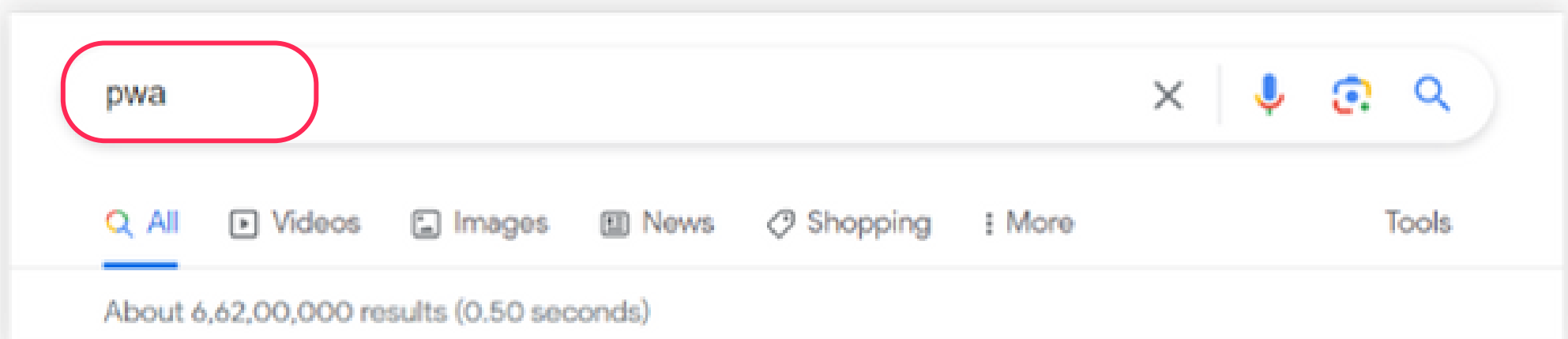
That's it. Now let's check how I did it in detail.

Step 1. Finding the questions


I extracted all the People Also Asked questions using **"SEO minion"** relevant to my niche in 3 simple steps.

- a.** Search the seed term on Google
- b.** Click on "PAA (5-Levels-2 mins)"
- c.** Download all the questions

a. Search the seed term on Google



b. Click on **"PAA (5-Levels-2 mins)"**

c. Download all the questions

Questions- SEO Minion
Is Shopify a headless CMS?
Is Shopify a headless commerce?
Is Shopify a headless eCommerce platform?

Is Spotify a PWA?

Step 2. Cluster them in the **right category**

Put all the questions in the **keyword clustering tool**. It will cluster all the similar types of questions. Remove the questions that mean exactly the same.

+ Does Shopify have headless? Total	
+ How much does a Magento 2 store cost in 2021? Total	
+ Does Elasticsearch use Solr? Total	
- Can I install PWA on iOS?	Does iOS support PWA?
	Does iOS have PWA?
	Does Apple support PWA?
	Can you use PWA on iOS?
	Can I install PWA on iOS?

I use **Keyword Insights** to cluster any given sequence of questions.

Once you have clustered them, you can **categorize these questions** on the site.

Definition	What is PWA eCommerce? What is a PWA storefront?
Examples	Is Spotify a PWA? Is Pinterest a PWA?
PWA Analytics	What is PWA in Google Analytics? How do I track PWA in Google Analytics?

Ask your web designer to design the page.

Step 3. Answer the questions as precisely as you can get.

- a.** Check existing featured snippet & note down their answer type.
- b.** Write answer in the same type, but make it better and non-opinionated.

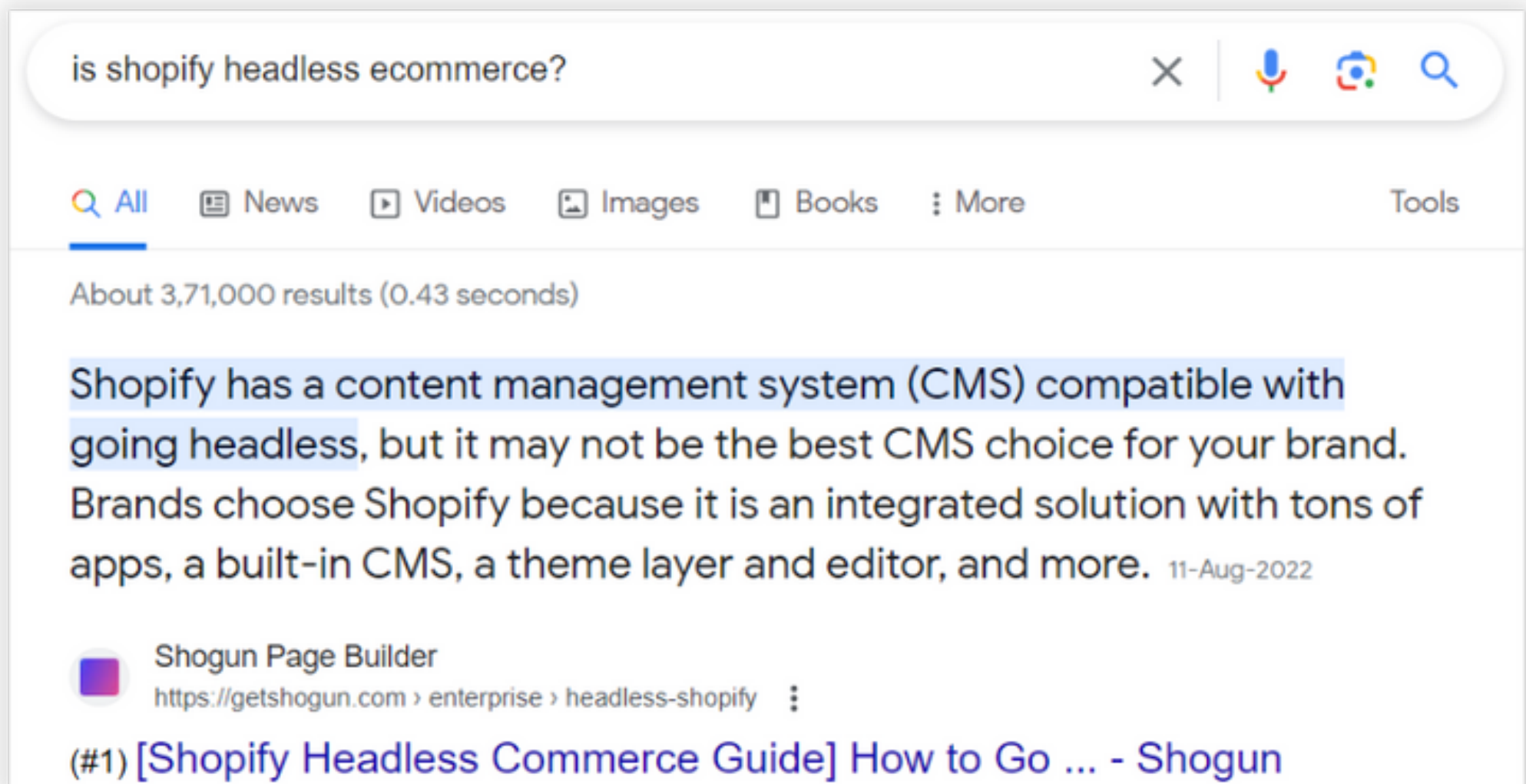
a. Check **existing featured snippet & note down their answer type**

They can be one among these:

- ✦ Paragraph
- ✦ Ordered List
- ✦ Unordered List
- ✦ Video
- ✦ Table

Example

The below FS is in paragraph format.

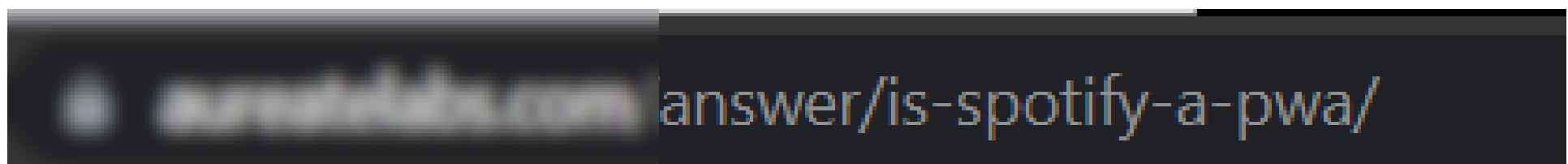


b. Write answer in the same format, but make it better and non-opinionated

- ✦ Use the same format
- ✦ Start your answer from the question itself.
 - Example: Is Spotify a PWA?
 - Answer: Yes, Spotify is a pwa...
 - Example, What is PWA for analytics?
 - Answer: PWA for analytics is... (definition)

Step 4. Create dedicated URLs

No matter how short the answer is, create a dedicated URL for such medium-volume questions.

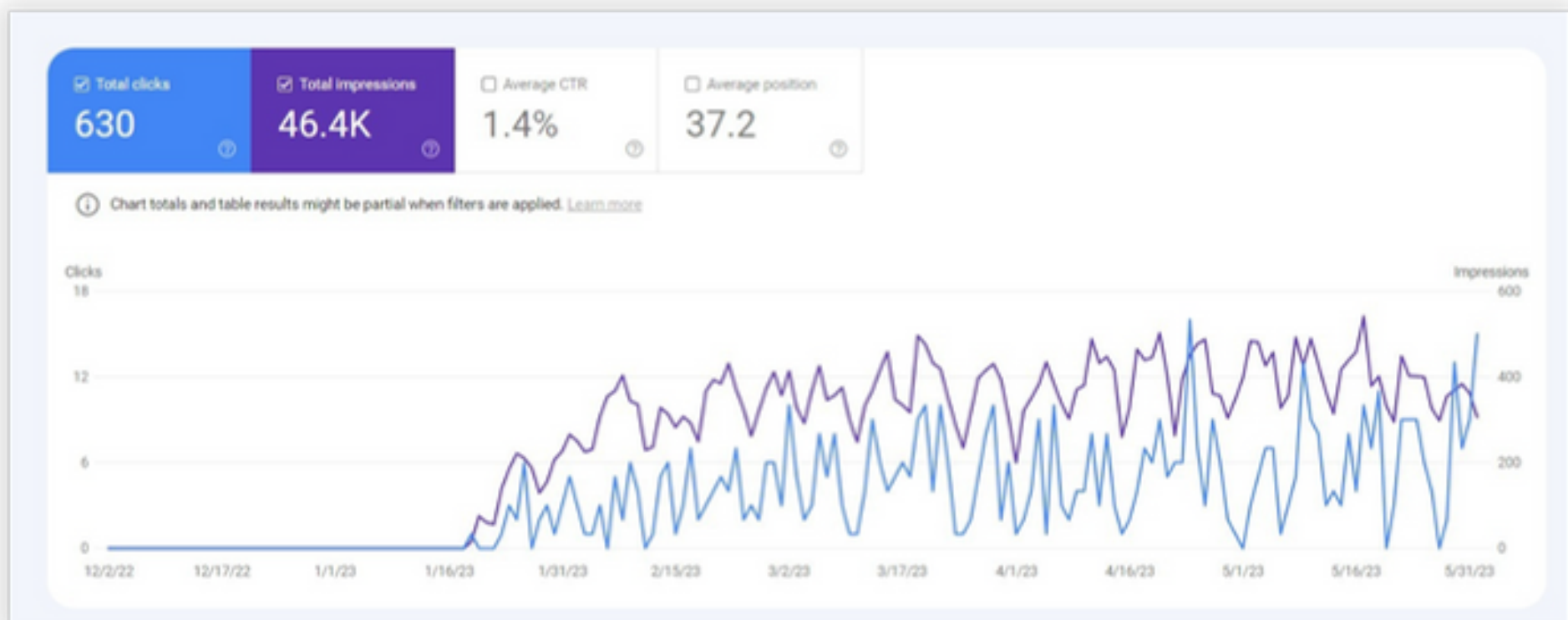


Google values search intent more than the length of the content. If your answer satisfies the intent, you've a high chance of bagging the FS.

Write **lots of questions** every month.

50 Questions * **50** words/ Month = **2500** words (hardly takes about **3-4** days to execute)

Repeat it for a good 6 months and see a regular stream of traffic flowing.



The above stat is for **38** questions, **50** words on an average.

Summary...

- ✦ Search the seed term on Google
- ✦ Use SEO minion
- ✦ Click on “PAA (5-Levels-2 mins)”
- ✦ Download all the questions
- ✦ Cluster the question with Keywords Insights
- ✦ Check the existing featured snippet
- ✦ Answer in the same format
- ✦ Write non-opinionated answers
- ✦ Dedicate a separate URL if needed
